The Neighborhood Watch program is the most effective means available for keeping crime out of our neighborhood. It relies on the best crime fighting tool ever invented – a watchful neighbor.

The program involves:

Neighbors getting to know each other, taking the time to care about each other and working together in a program of mutual assistance. Keeping a log of names of homeowners or renters. Citizens being trained to recognize and report suspicious activities in their neighborhood.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Be alert to unusual or suspicious behavior in your neighborhood. Call the sheriff if warranted. Write down descriptions of the person(s) and license numbers of any vehicles involved. **Contact 911 to get a patrol car ASAP to** check out what you see at the time it happens.

Tell a trusted neighbor if your house will be unoccupied for an extended period. Tell them how to reach you in an emergency. Inform your Block Captain that you are away.

Look after your neighbors' homes when they are away, and ask them to look after yours. This includes picking up mail or newspapers and putting back the garbage cans or recycling bins. Don't leave signals that say, "no one is home."

The non-emergency Sheriff's Department: 974-0845 is the number to use if you want to notify them you will be out of town and would like them to patrol by your house. When you call, do not select any of the options mentioned in the recording, stay on hold and a representative will eventually pick up the line. Be prepared to answer questions about your property, your absence and who might be visiting the house while you are away.
