A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT...

As your new incoming President as of the Annual Meeting on May 5th, 2019, I would like to welcome all our new neighbors and say hello to our existing neighbors. We are so fortunate to live in this wonderful neighborhood! I moved here in June 1975 (I can't believe it has been almost 45 years!!) knowing this would be the perfect place to raise a famiy, which it was, and now my 12 grandchildren (and one on the way!) get to enjoy it as well!. Back then, it was really quiet and not much traffic at all. Of course, all that has changed! But it still has a country feel with such big lots and so many beautiful oak trees. And SO much more convenient shopping!

And as our homes and our yards get older, it does get a bit challenging at times to keep up. But I truly hope that we all keep a sense of great pride in where we live. We do have Restrictions for the neighborhood (they are posted on our website www.ocmpoa.org) and a Restriction Committee to help keep those Restrictions enforced. The Restrictions are not overly restrictive and our intention is not to police the neighborhood but to make sure everyone follows the rules and to keep our neighborhood beautiful and safe. Over the last six months we have had several complaints: running a mechanic shop in the front yard, junk piling up, porches falling down, old cars in the yard, new homes not being compliant with the 50% masonry rules, and more. Our Restriction Committee Chair, Christopher Mitchell, has a very tough role but has done an outstanding job contacting these owners and getting results. We sincerely ask for your help in keeping Onion Creek Meadows subdivision a great place to live.

In order to change or add any Restrictions, we need a quorum of 51% of the property owners. We have 247 lots and only 90 OCMPOA members. A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT...CONT'D

One of our neighbors suggested that we put a street light at the corner of Old San Antonio Road and Onion Creek Drive. So we called Pedernales Electric Coop and found out that the pole was already there, we just needed to have them install a light. So, for only \$10 to \$12 per month, we now have visibility at that corner making it safer for everyone. We checked into putting a light at Turley and Old San Antonio Road, but there is no pole on that corner and the expense is cost prohibitive.

On July 10, 2019 OCMPOA held a Community Meeting at Manchaca Fire & Rescue and invited County Commissioner Gerald Daugherty to come speak on several important issues in the Manchaca community:

- Traffic light needed at Old San Antonio Road & FM 1626
- Old San Antonio needs widening with a bike lane
- Twin Creeks Road needs widening and turn lanes into the new Bear Creek Crossing subdivision and right turn lane at Twin Creeks Road and FM 1626
- Update on plans for the new bridge on Old San Antonio Road over Onion Creek

Over 60 people from all over the Manchaca area attended. Commissioner Daugherty also brought his Assistant Bob Moore and Traffic Engineer with Travis County, Andre' Betit who was very helpful in explaining the road and bridge plans. To see the complete minutes of the meeting, please go to our website www.ocmpoa.org. Many of the attendees thanked us for setting up the meeting as it was indeed needed and helpful.

When walking in the neighborhood, I have noticed that many of our trees, especially the old heritage oaks, are covered with ball moss which is very harmful to trees and can actually eventually kill the tree. I have contacted a local Tree Service to see if they would give us a discount if we had several neighbors who needed ball moss removal, tree trimming or removal. They are willing to give a 10% discount if we can get 5 or more neighbors to participate. Update on local developments: Estancia is starting to clear off land for Phase 2 for 90 townhomes to be built toward the one lane bridge. Bear Creek Crossing has sold almost all the lots in Phase I and will soon be starting on Phase 2. Hopefully, the County, City and State will start working on the issues for OSA Road and Twin Creeks Road soon to help alleviate some of the traffic woes.
